permit, which is expected by mid-February. Hyundai has expressed a desire to move into high gear on the project. They plan to operate two shifts six days a week once construction begins.

California City beat out two other finalists and secured an agreement with Hyundai to construct a \$50 million dollar automotive test facility south of the city. Promising to be an economic boost to California City's continued growth, the test track facility will employ over 50 people year-round, with seasonal positions that will result in around 50 additional jobs. Hyundai will require thousands of gallons of gasoline, as well as office and vehicle supplies that they will be purchasing locally. Nearby restaurants can expect an increase in business as well. The facility will include several tracks, maintenance buildings and other facilities.

Hyundai hopes to open the track by mid-summer.
